C786/20 Britons Lane, Beeston Regis – Essential Footway Resurfacing

Work will begin on Monday 30 September 2024 to resurface the section of footway which runs alongside the grass verge on Britons Lane, Beeston Regis and leads into Priory Close. The works will see the damaged and worn-out surface removed and replaced with new edging, as well as being extended approximately 10 metres to join up with the existing footway on Priory Close. These works are expected to take approximately 4 weeks to complete, subject to suitable weather conditions.

The road will be closed during these works but access to properties will be maintained. Anyone who has any specific access requirements, can contact us using the email address below or speak to the team on site, so these access requirements can be accommodated.

The work which will cost approximately £35,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Infrastructure Department and their contractors.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this surface improvement work is carried out.
